2/ The Strategic National Stockpile was transferred administratively from CDC to ASPR in FY 2019. This Operating Plan reflects the transfer of FY 2019 Enacted funding consistent with the OMB Determination Order, including a Secretarial transfer of \$6.1 million from the SNS budget to CDC for transition costs.

3/ The Pandemic Influenza appropriations are reflected within the Office of the Secretary PHSSEF consistent with the current organization of the program and not the table in the FY 2020 report which includes this funding with OASH.
