

Guide to 106-107 Survey Report

The accompanying report is based on a compilation of responses from Texas State agencies and universities to a survey on P. L. 106-107. **The Overview and Sections 1, 3, 4, 7, 8, and 11 may interest all Federal agencies**, including the lead federal agency, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. Section 1, titled “Grant Simplification,” is divided into six areas of: Application Process, Awarding Process, Information Access, Reporting Process, Drawing Federal Cash, and Other. (Please note that Texas State agency and university responses are not intended to be official state of Texas policy.)
