
MFP Program Overview

- expand the array of community-base



- Requiring program benchmarks





- Increases in available and accessible supportive services



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
MFP Quality Management System

- Risk assessment and mitigation process
- A 24 hour emergency back-up system
- Incident report management system

- Supplemental Services:** One-time or limited-duration services






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
MFP Expansion





MFP Transitions


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- ❑ Through 2012, States plan to transition over 23,000 individuals.
- ❑ States started to accelerate the number of transitions this fiscal year after a very slow start.
- ❑ CMS is expecting the total number of transitions to approach 10,000 by January 2011

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MFP Rebalancing Demonstration

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- Increase the availability of Home and Community Based Services.
- Investment in additional services and infrastructure needed to sustain each state's rebalancing program
- Improve the overall long-term care system
