He designed, developed, implemented, and evaluated two pharmacy based patient clinics, the Anticoagulant Clinic and the Cardiovascular Risk Reduction Clinic. He also developed an ACPE accredited continuing education and certificate training program with a mission of improving the knowledge of Indian Health Service pharmacists, nurses, and physicians in the area of anticoagulation.
