Overview of Performance Measures Contract

- Purpose
 - To develop performance measures that will accurately reflect the progress and accomplishments of OAH/ACF and the Teenage Pregnancy Prevention Initiative grantees
 - To develop the data collection instruments and systems for reporting data related to the proposed measures
- First Year Activities
 - Conduct literature review
 - Develop performance measures in consultation with expert panel
 - Develop data collection instruments
 - Develop reporting system
 - Provide training and technical assistance



Activities

- Submit literature review
- Develop conceptual model
- Convene expert panel
- Recommendations for performance measures
- Develop draft instruments
- Pilot test instruments
- Propose recommendations for data collection tools
- Develop data collection reporting system
- OMB clearance package
- Provide training & TA
- Collect PM data



Key Goals of Performance Measurement

- **Accountability**
 - Typically to external stakeholders (e.g., OMB, Congress, public)
- **Program Performance Management**
 - Typically for internal program leadership to help guide program management
- **Ideally, these two goals are interrelated**
- **Importance of Performance Measurement to OAH/ACF**
