Model Reminders

The final lists of ICD-10 exclusion categories and hip fracture codes for FY 2017 are now available.

In the CJR final rule, CMS finalized a process for updating the list of ICD-10 categories excluded from CJR episodes (80 FR 73305), as well as a process for updating the ICD-10 diagnosis codes used to identify hip fractures (80 FR 73340). In accordance with these update processes, the CJR model team has posted files containing the final modifications to these lists on the CMS website at: https://innovation.cms.gov/initiatives/CJR. These lists are effective as of October 1, 2016.

October 31, 2016 is the deadline to submit voluntary pre-operative patientreported outcome (PRO) and risk variable data for Performance Year 1.

CJR participants can submit pre-operative PRO and risk variable data collected on patients who received eligible primary total hip arthroplasty and total knee arthroplasty procedures between July 1 - August 31, 2016. Frequently Asked Questions Highlight: Overlap between CJR and the Bundled Payments for Care Improvement (BPCI) Initiative

Q: CMS has applied "precedence" to BPCI Model 2 and Model 3 physician group practice (PGP) and post-acute care (PAC) provider lower extremity joint replacement (LEJR) episodes. What does this mean?

A: If at any time during a CJR LEJR episode, that beneficiary would also be in a BPCI Model 2 or Model 3 LEJR episode, the beneficiary's CJR episode would either not be initiated or would be canceled. The episode would not be included in the participant hospital's CJR reconciliation. Several examples are provided on page 73389 of the CJR final rule.
