




# What's in the CJR Model Toolkit 3.0?



**The CJR Model Toolkit 3.0 is now available on [CJR Connect](#)! Download and share it with your colleagues today.**

The Toolkit includes a compilation of change concepts, strategies, tactics, tools, and resources used by CJR participant hospitals to support their CJR model implementation, improvement, and sustainability efforts. The Toolkit was updated based on data collected by the CJR Learning System from a subset of participant hospitals during Performance Years 1-5.






Version 3.0 of the Toolkit includes new examples and strategies related to topics such as:
