# Purpose

The following tutorial will cover instructions for requesting a new CMS Enterprise Portal Account.

You will create your own CMS Enterprise Portal ID, also referred to as Enterprise Identity Management ID, or EIDM ID.

## The Quality Measures Assessment Tool


The Quality Measures Assessment Tool (QMAT) is a web-based application allowing users to submit clinical data for quality measure calculations through Quality Reporting Document Architecture (QRDA) file uploads or manual data entry. QMAT will also perform data validation and calculate quality performance scores. Reporting functions available will allow users to view progress and provide feedback regarding performance.

CMS is very aware of the privacy concerns around PII data. In fact, we share your concerns. We will only collect personal data to uniquely identify the user registering with the system. We may also use your answers to the challenge questions and other PII to later identify you in case you forget or misplace your User ID /Password.

I have read the HHS Rules of Behavior (HHS RoB), version 2010-0002.001S, dated August 26 2010 and understand and agree to comply with its provisions.
