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Adding Newborns in December 2014

- In rare cases, newborns are being added into 2014 coverage effective December 2014
- Due to technical limitations, the Federally-facilitated Marketplace (FFM) cannot send a mid-month date of birth (DOB) for a newborn born in December 2014
- In these cases, the FFM will send an enrollment transaction with a 12/1/14 coverage effective date
 - A Health Insurance Casework System (HICS) case will instruct the issuer to adjust the effective date and DOB
 - To update the FFM to the correct mid-month date, issuers should update the 2014 effective date and DOB through the ER&R reconciliation dispute process
 - Issuers should use the 1095-A tab on the dispute form
