Passive Cancels

Passive Cancels

- Will cancel passive reenrollments that duplicate active enrollments for future year Marketplace coverage.
- If enrollees or their assisters create a duplicate enrollment via a disconnected application, the Marketplace will cancel the passive enrollment
 - Delivery: 11/21, 11/28, 12/5, and 12/20.
 - EFT BARCN9 jobs (IPA layout)
- Issuers may alternatively send a IC834 cancel on the duplicate 2019 passive rather than waiting for the BARCN9 job

Carry Forward Cancels

- Will cancel auto-reenrollments that are subsequently ineligible for BAR due to late terminations of current year Marketplace coverage. Active reenrollments or auto-reenrollments that have been updated by the enrollee will NOT be cancelled in this job, though in some scenarios the issuer may still cancel the active reenrollment (see Exchange Enrollment Manual, Chapter 6)
- Carry Forward Cancels are delivered to issuers via EFT I834's with AMRC CANCEL-CARRYFORWARD

Carry Forward Cancels – Delivery Dates

11/23/2018

- Cancel BAR policies still in passive status (origin = 11) via I834 cancel if 2018 policy termed after BAR;
- Carry forward to the 2019 BAR policy in passive status any 2018 change accepted by the FFE after BAR (such as a consumer report of a life change or a change accepted in enrollment data alignment)

12/3/2018

- Auto-renew 2018 enrollments created (or reinstated) after October 10 (first incremental run)
- Cancel BAR policies still in passive status (origin = 11) via I834 cancel if 2018 policy termed after BAR;
- Carry forward to the 2019 BAR policy in passive status any 2018 change accepted by the FFE after BAR (such as a consumer report of a life change or a change accepted in enrollment data alignment)

12/18/2018

- Auto-renew 2018 enrollments created (or reinstated) after December 3 (second incremental run)
- Cancel BAR policies still in passive status (origin = 11) via I834 cancel if 2018 policy termed after BAR; carry forward to the 2019 BAR policy in passive status any 2018 change accepted by the FFE after BAR (such as a consumer report of a life change or a change accepted in enrollment data alignment)

Missing Outbound Incremental Pre-Audit (MOIPA9) File Delivery

- MOIPA9
 - This file is a special Incremental Pre-Audit File that will contain full information for enrollment transactions that failed to convey to the Issuer via the standard EDI 834. This IPA File will contain the full Pre-Audit information for all enrollment transactions including BAR that failed to convey successfully to the Issuer during the period covered by the ISUIPA.
 - Delivery on: 11/20, 11/26, and 12/10
- BAR policies created but not sent as 834s will also show up on a MOIPA
