Inputs Required

- QHP Service Area Template
- The county name and ZIP codes requested in the partial county service area
- The Partial County Service Area Justification supplemental response
 - The recommended form is available at http://www.cms.gov/CCIIO/Programs-and-Initiatives/Health-Insurance-Marketplaces/qhp.html
- Evidence from the appropriate State regulator indicating that the partial county request is approved by the state



Completing Your Partial County Service Area Justification Supplemental Response

- Describe how serving this partial county geographic area is necessary. Describe the evidence that you are providing to substantiate this and (if applicable) include it with your response.
- Describe how serving this partial county geographic area is not discriminatory. Describe the evidence that you are providing to substantiate this and (if applicable) include it with your response.
- Describe how serving this partial county geographic area is in the best interest of the qualified individuals and employers. Describe the evidence that you are providing to substantiate this and (if applicable) include it with your response.

Submitting Your Partial County Service Area Justification Supplemental Response

- Provide responses to all questions in the justification form:
 - The form is recommended, not required, but your justification will need to address the criteria it outlines.
- Obtain State authorization:
 - Issuers submitting QHP data in HIOS:
 - Include written evidence of State authorization. No specific format is required.
 - Issuers submitting QHP data in SERFF (new for PY2017):
 - Successful transfer of service area data will be accepted as State authorization.



Submitting Your Partial County Service Area Justification Supplemental Response

- In the Partial County Service Area column of the Service Area template, enter the name of the compiled justification file using the following convention:
 - [Issuer ID]-Partial County-[Service Area ID]-[County Name]
 - Ex: 12345-Partial County-MDS001-Montgomery.pdf
- Upload the combined document into the Plan & Benefit section of the Benefits & Service Area module in the Qualified Health Plan (QHP) Application System using the document upload functionality. Select Other from the Document Type drop-down menu.



Tips for Requesting a Partial County Service Area

- Use current USPS ZIP codes to complete your template.
- Double-check to make sure you're requesting all the ZIP codes and counties where you intend to offer plans.
- Be thorough in your supplemental response, and provide written evidence to support your justification.
- If your service area is denied for an insufficient justification, closely review the comments provided in your Correction Notice for the additional information required.

Best Practices for Submitting- Help Desk Tickets

- Include HIOS ID, issuer State and issuer legal name
- Include screenshots or attach templates when asking about an error or issue with the template
- Submit separate Help Desk requests for different, unrelated questions
- Put the question in the body of the email; do not attach Excel or Word documents with lists of questions
- Identify or note whether question is for the SHOP or Individual Marketplace
