Purpose

 This session will provide submission instructions and guidelines specific to the Transitional Adjustment Data Collection.



Transitional Adjustment Data Collection: Background

- On November 14, 2013, CMS announced a policy under which it will not consider certain individual or small group coverage that is renewed for a policy year starting after January 1, 2014 to be out of compliance with specified 2014 Market Rules (CMS transitional policy). CMS requested that states adopt a similar non-enforcement policy.
- To help mitigate the transitional policy's effect on the risk pool for Qualified Health Plan (QHP) issuers in the 2014 Benefit Year, CMS implemented a state-level adjustment to the Risk Corridors formula.
- This session will provide an overview of the Transitional Adjustment Data Collection that will be used to calculate the Risk Corridors adjustment percentage for 2014, as defined in 45 CFR 153.500.

Transitional Adjustment Reporting Form: Required Submitters

All companies that offered health insurance coverage in the individual or small group market in 2014, in a state that adopted the CMS transitional policy (transitional state), must submit a Transitional Adjustment Reporting Form.

- Submissions are required for ALL individual and small group plans, offered in transitional states (listed on the following slide).
- Submission is not limited to QHP issuers only.
- Issuers in transitional states must submit a Transitional Adjustment Reporting Form even if they do not have enrollment in transitional policies.
- Each company should submit one (1) Transitional Adjustment Reporting Form for all issuers, in each transitional state.

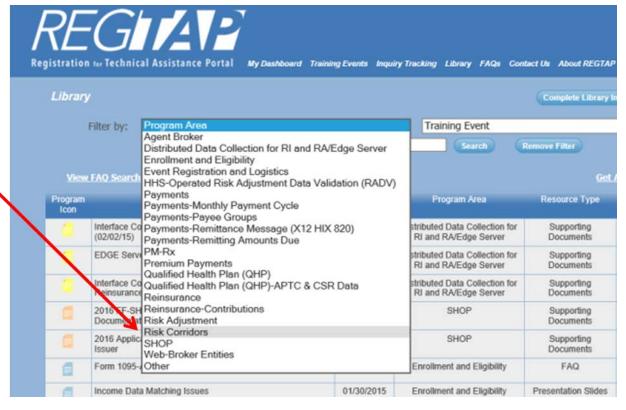

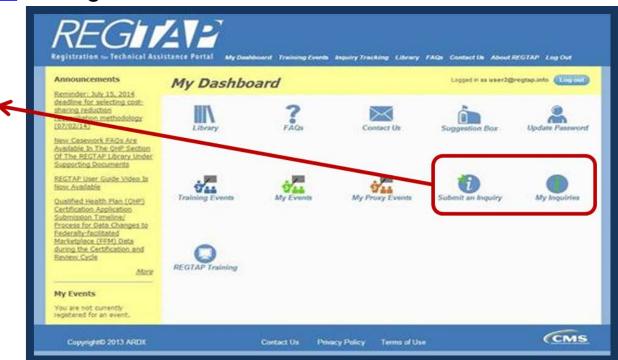

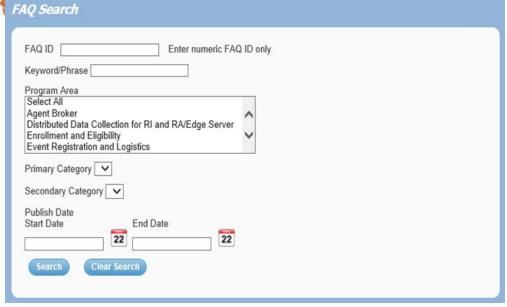


FAQ Database on REGTAP
