This change request (CR) will eliminate the manual intervention required to finalize claims when reason code 31407 assigns incorrectly.

**A. Background:** MACs were instructed via technical direction to deactivate/activate Reason Code 31407 to process claims when multiple units are billed with HCPCS G2025 on bill type 71X. The MACs deactivate RC 31407, release claims with bill type 71x, and immediately reactivate RC 31407.

MACs have been manually deactivating/activating Reason Code 31407 since April 2020 and would like FISS to make this reason code overridable.
