SUBJECT: Revised Rhode Island-Specific Reporting Requirements

The purpose of this memorandum is to announce the release of the revised Medicare-Medicaid Capitated Financial Alignment Model Reporting Requirements: Rhode Island-Specific Reporting Requirements. These documents provide updated technical specifications for the state-specific measures that the Rhode Island Medicare-Medicaid Plan (MMP) is required to collect and report under the demonstration.

Please see below for a summary of the substantive changes to the Rhode Island-Specific Reporting Requirements as compared to the prior versions: 1) issued February 29, 2024 and amended February 28, 2025 (the 2024 version) and 2) issued February 28, 2025 (the 2025 version). The updated 2024 version incorporates the change noted below and should be used for measures due before June 2, 2025. The updated 2025 version also incorporates the change noted below and should be used for measures due on or after June 2, 2025. These changes did not affect the Rhode Island-Specific Value Sets Workbooks.

SUMMARY OF CHANGES

Measure RI4.5

- In the Notes section, revised the criteria for identifying data element B to include the A2105 discharge status code “12 Home under care of organized home health service organization” to align with updated specifications from the measure steward (CMS/Minimum Data Set [MDS]).
