This change shall only be applicable to multiple page ADS letters. No changes shall be made to the first page of a multiple page ADS letter.

Multiple page ADS letters shall have page numbering applied and a reduced amount of information to include only the addressee name, Medicare Identification Number (MID) and the Internal Control Number (ICN). This shall be printed at the top of all pages other than the first page of a multiple page ADS letter.
