In order to maximize efficiency and cost savings in preparation for the J2 MAC implementation, CMS will merge the four Part A workloads (Alaska, Washington, Idaho and Oregon) into a single CICS region for user acceptance testing and a single CICS production region.

The contractor workload numbers will remain the same following this merge. However, when there are multiple workload numbers within a single FISS CICS region, the workloads need to be processed using a rollup number. Therefore a temporary contractor workload rollup number (00326) will be assigned. CMS will not at this time split the Part A Alaska and Washington or Idaho and Oregon workloads into separate workloads for workload reporting purposes. However, CMS will need to do so at the time of the eventual J2 A/B MAC transition, at which time the appropriate change request will be published.
