Re: Medicare Parts C & D Fraud Alert: Payment Suspension for Billing for Medically

Unnecessary Services and Kickback Payments

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) was notified by the Office of Investigations, Office of Inspector General (HHS-OIG) of allegations that twelve (12) different providers are engaged in schemes to defraud the Medicare Parts C and D programs. We are alerting you to this information so that you can take the appropriate actions regarding these providers and the Part C and D benefits you offer. These actions should be focused on the appropriate detection and identification of fraud, waste and abuse as required under the Part C and D programs.

The pharmacies and providers listed are alleged to be engaged in schemes to defraud healthcare programs. The subjects' NPI numbers and locations are listed below.

We recommend that you take immediate action to review the allegations below and determine whether you have been impacted by one or more of the alleged fraud schemes.
