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### RECOMMENDATION TO SECRETARY:

The working group on education in CFS/ME recommends that HHS provide opportunities for dissemination of information through the use of the CFS Primer; Integrative Medicine programs that can develop webinars and other types of academic workshops; use of Wikipedia and other web based informational sites; and the use of established organizations, such as the American College of Physicians.



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Chronic Fatigue Syndrome ME is an underserved community. It requires more research and education. To have Centers of Excellence, several around the country will help address these two problems. These can be used to provide virtual support to doctors out in the community. They provide referral centers for most complicated patients. They provide centers for research. They present educational opportunities.
