In accordance with the relevant provisions of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), the purpose of this correspondence is to request certain information maintained by the Office of Medicare Hearings and Appeals (OMHA) within the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. 5 U.S.C. § 552 et seg.; 45 C.F.R. § 5.1 et seg.

We hereby request disposition data related to Medicare claim appeals adjudicated by all OMHA Administrative Law Judges (ALJs) from 10/25/22 to the date of this correspondence. This data will presumably reflect the claim type (i.e., Medicare Part A, B, C, D) and the results of the decisions (i.e., favorable, partially favorable, unfavorable) according to claim type. We also anticipate this data would reflect the total number of appeals adjudicated by these ALJs (broken down by quarter or calendar year) within the timeframe of our request.
