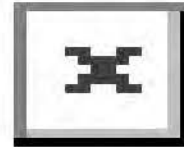

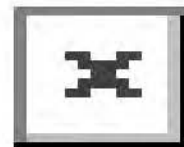

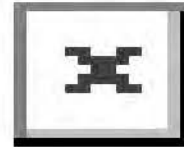

Republicans Are Abandoning Their ACA Attacks.

Recommend Approval Of Controversial ALS Drug.

Members of the Food and Drug Administration on Wednesday voted 7 to 2 to recommend approval of an experimental ALS drug with strong support from patients and advocates. The FDA is expected to make a final decision on the drug, which is being marketed by a small biotech company, within weeks.
