Fluoridation of public water systems is a local decision. HHS PHS recommends a water fluoridation level, so the inquiry should be targeted to HHS (Admiral Levine's group). I am also ccing Goncalo in NCTR, since he has been involved in agency wide fluoride issues. FYI, EPA only regulates naturally occurring fluoride.

We have established allowable levels for fluoridation of bottled water in line with PHS recommendations.

Dear Dr. Jones,

I am writing to you again given the alarming news I received today regarding Dr. Rachel Levine and water fluoridation.

Who in HHS did you pass along our meeting materials on to which explained the neurotoxicity of fluoride in drinking water? I will need to know their names and titles for follow up in light of the disturbing news today.

It is important that HHS place an immediate federal moratorium on fluoride injected in drinking water, to remove expectant mothers and protect the neurological health of their offspring.

I look forward to hearing from you and those copied here regarding the deliberate withholding of this important maternal and pediatric environmental health protection from the American public.

I am also copying the US Department of Justice, Environmental Justice Office, because they were asked to investigate this matter since their opening in 2021.

An extensive history of federal agencies covering up harm from environmental hazards, allowing expectant mothers to remain in harm's way, has been investigated on many fronts by Congress. These hearings have been instrumental in revealing agency abuse of power to citizens, resulting in irretrievable and life altering environmental health losses. You may recall that I met with you and a team of experts on the neurotoxicity of fluoride when Flint, Michigan, was being water poisoned in real time, due to catastrophic agency responses.

Please provide the "compelling evidence" you were given to Dr. Levine from our meeting, follow up, and the ongoing correspondences from me since then. It is critical she allows Dr. Wolfe to do her job.

I was water poisoned in the state of Georgia while living in an environmental justice community. Our endangerment from a "major public health hazard" was identified while we remained in harm's way as GA EPD and US EPA negotiated in secret with our perpetrators.

This institutional betrayal to victims was a violation of the law on victims' rights then and now. HHS must no longer be complicit in the matter of water fluoridation.

I look forward to hearing from you promptly.

I want to bring to your attention also, a letter you both received dated, December 19, 2014. This was a follow up letter from a meeting that I organized with HHS, when Dr. Jones was positioned in authority, and heard "compelling evidence" (her words) on the neurotoxicity of fluoride in drinking water.

This "compelling evidence" presented, described real time "brain drain" on a national level. This scientific information provided HHS the opportunity to authorize the Office of the Surgeon General, to take appropriate action to eliminate permanent adverse neurological impacts, on our most vulnerable citizens.

Dr. Jones took it upon herself to not inform the Surgeon General to take action, or to issue a public statement through HHS, that expectant mothers should avoid fluoride in drinking water, and refrain from using it in reconstituted infant formula for their babies.

To the FDA, the letter expressed that it was imperative the agency take responsibility in the interim of a moratorium, and generate a new drug review (NDR).

This request was made to assist the Surgeon General to potentially permanently ban fluoride from drinking water. Pending the FDA outcome of the safety and effectiveness of fluoride in treating teeth through drinking water, a NDR would hasten the protection of our nation's most vulnerable citizens.

Dr. Woodcock chose on her own volition, as head of CDER at the time, to not do this NDR. It also remained unclear from FDA, if Dr. Woodcock shut down drug trials where expectant mothers and their offspring were being experimented on with fluoride.

I held this meeting in 2014, at the same time citizens were being water poisoned in Flint, Michigan. Federal agencies were choosing to walk down an abuse of power road, rather than utilize the emergency authority they possessed by Congress. The power to immediately remove the Flint citizens from harm's way was thwarted. The damage perpetrated to the victims of Flint, was irreversible, and in all reality, criminal.

I want to turn your attention now to Cleveland, GA. Cleveland is home to a Christian college, where I've attended basketball games when my son played.

It is home to Cabbage Patch Kids, and a lived childhood experience, where families can visit. My young granddaughter has visited twice to bring her dolls home from Cabbage Patch Hospital.

Cleveland, GA is also the place my college roommate met her husband, both committing their lives together, to serve the Lord, as leaders in teaching children in a Christian school, and pastoring a Christian church.

I see Cleveland as holy ground, where God works in the lives of people, to take the goodness of Jesus to a broken world. It is a place where children in their innocence, go to experience joy and the sacredness of family.

Now the CDC has chosen to experiment on Cleveland, GA residents with fluoride. I don't think The Good Shepherd is pleased with this abuse of power.

This human experimentation is ungodly, immoral, unethical, and should be illegal.

In your current positions of power, with the duties that equip you with significant access to protect the vulnerable, I resubmit my follow up letter from 2014, for your consideration.

Will you take action this time around?

Please let me know you have located your copy of the letter in your files, and will present it to your bosses. If you need another copy, let me know.

With this re-submission, I ask that you take action here and now. The concerns brought before you at the close of 2014, have grown in urgency. With peer reviewed, published studies generated in the past eight years, this exceptional work warrants your attention.

Please see that the FDA Commissioner and the Surgeon General confer on this weight of evidence to place a moratorium on water fluoridation.

It is extremely critical to begin addressing the neurotoxicant silent pandemic, identified by pediatric environmental health experts, Drs. Philippe Grandjean and Phil Landrigan, by removing fluoride from drinking water.

Please let me know if you have any questions. Also, once you have provided the 2014 letter to FDA Commissioner & Surgeon General, please inform me of the appropriate action HHS and FDA intends to pursue to remove citizens from this endangerment.

Your power and position should be used at this time to protect the vulnerable in Cleveland, GA, and around the country.

Your intervention will bless them from being victims of abuse of power and irretrievable losses, that will be perpetrated onto them by the CDC.
