The HDW then summarizes them for publication and analysis on maps, dashboard, and reports. The information is used by public and private individuals and agencies to promote health care to under-served areas by studying the data retrieved by the HDW. Data are refreshed from the source systems on schedules that vary from daily to annual to as desired. Each refresh replaces the previous data.
