Where Modern Human Research Protections Were Shaped

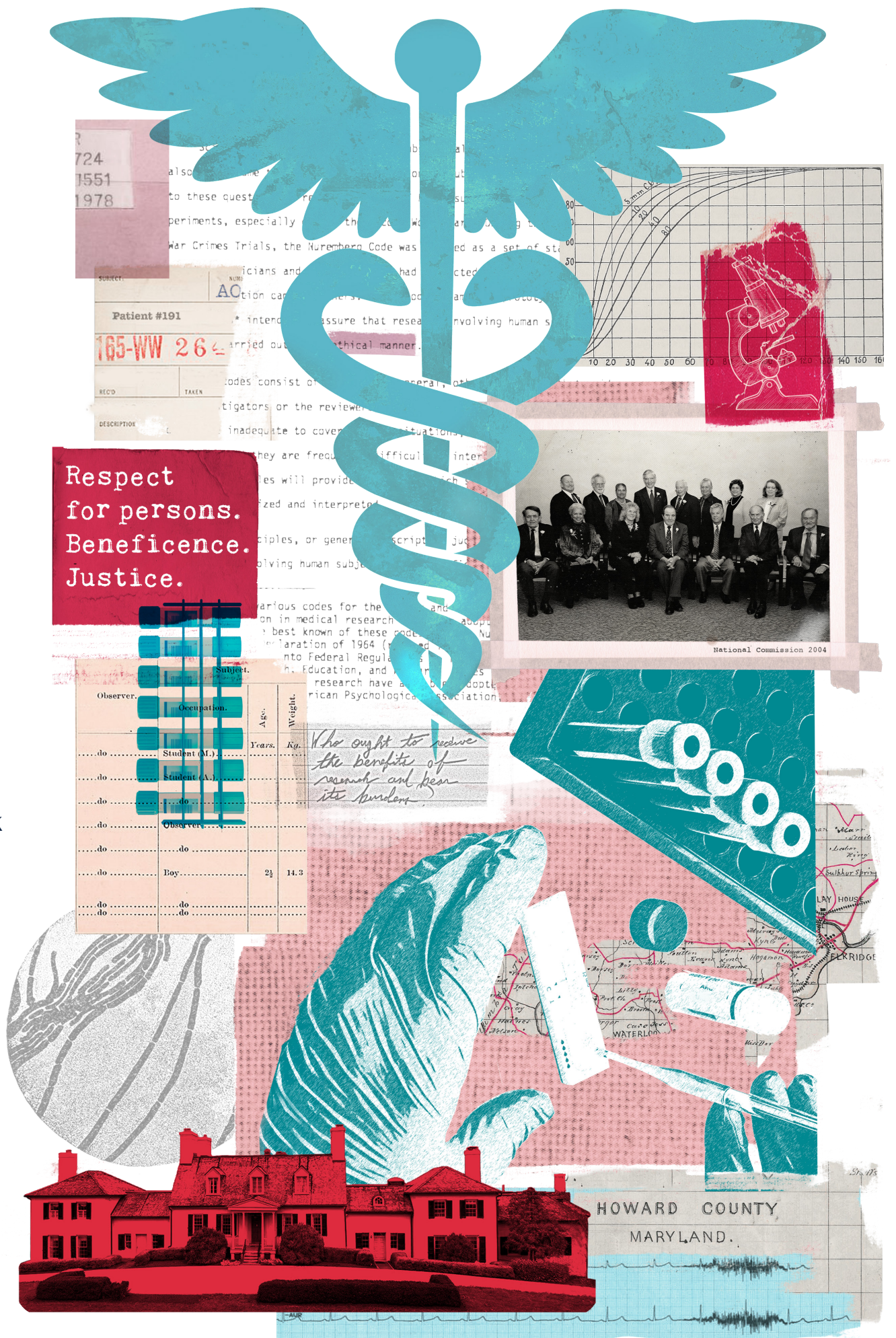
