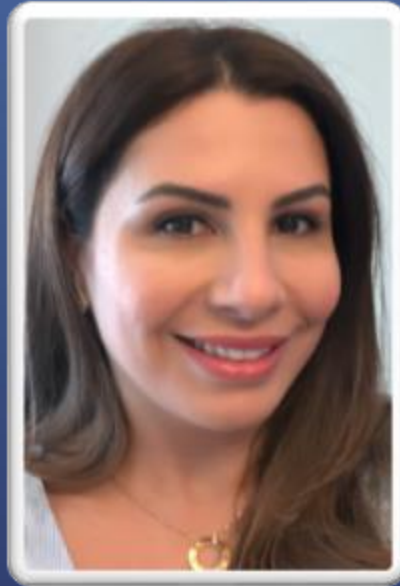

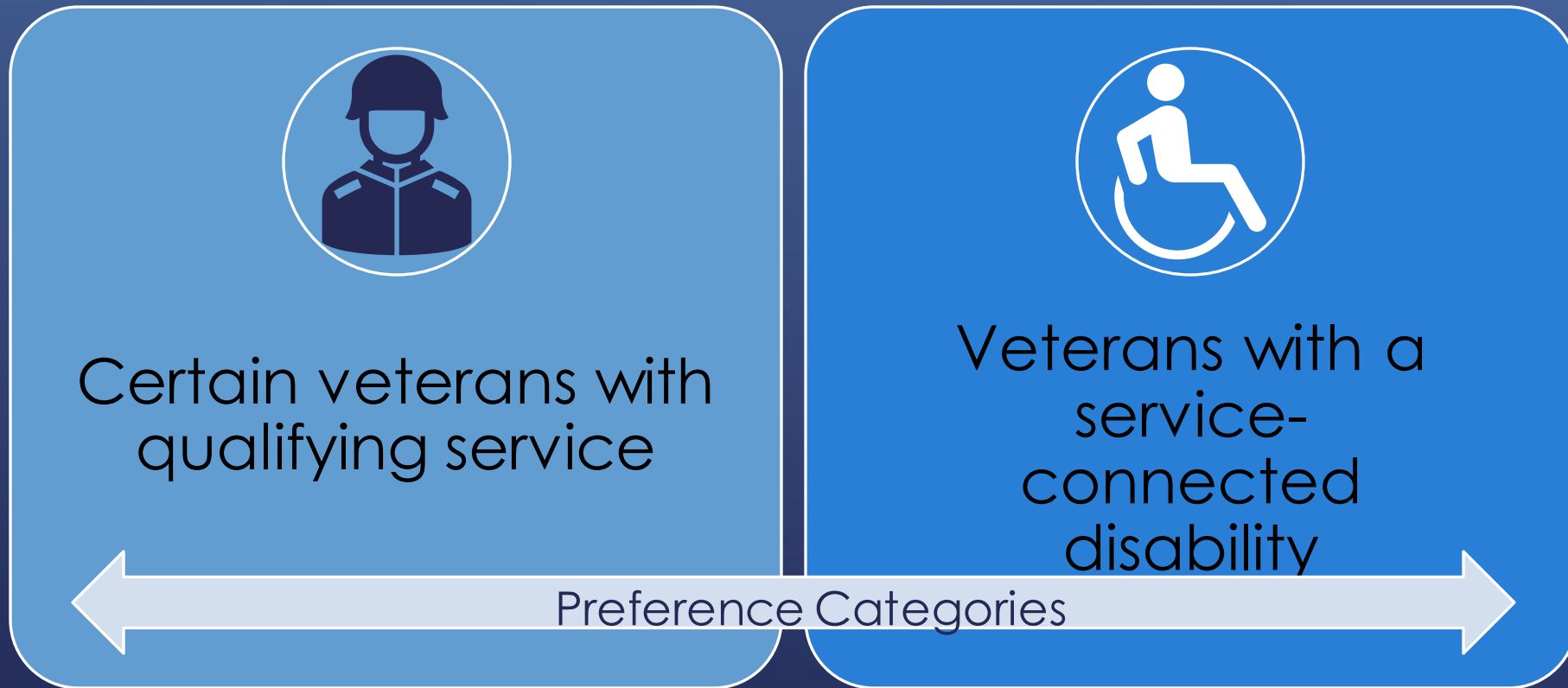

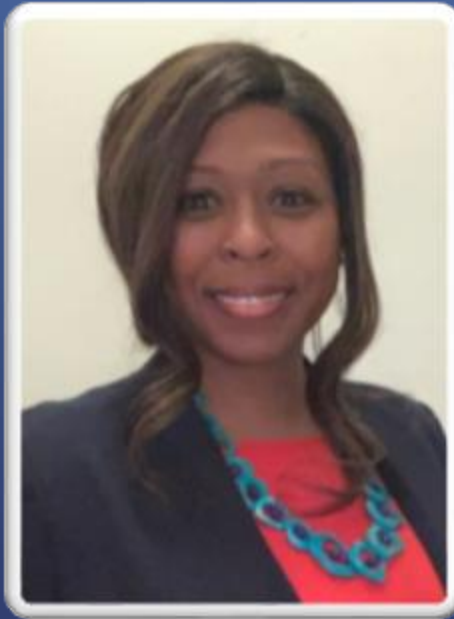

MILITARY SPOUSES EXECUTIVE ORDER 13832

- ❖ Provides Noncompetitive Civil Service Appointments of Military Spouses
- ❖ Appointing Authority allows agencies to appoint certain military spouses without using traditional competitive examining
- ❖ Military Spouses possess the mission critical skills needed by the Federal Government
- ❖ Agencies can appoint noncompetitively:
 - ▶ The spouse of a member of the armed forces on active duty
 - ▶ The spouse of a 100 percent disabled member of the armed forces
 - ▶ The spouse of a deceased member of the armed forces
